DIRECTIONS TO LAC LAVON PARK

15501 Lac Lavon Drive, Burnsville, MN 55337

From the North: Take 35E South to County Rd 42 Exit. Left (east) on 42 to Lac Lavon Drive. Right on Lac Lavon Drive for 1.5 miles. Park is on the Left side. Watch for event signs!!

From the South: Take 35 North to County Rd 46 Exit. Left (east) on 46 (46 becomes 162nd Street West). Left on Lac Lavon Drive. Park is on right side. Watch for event signs!!

From the East: 94 West to 35E South to County Rd 42 Exit.. Left (east) on County Rd 42 to Lac Lavon Drive. Turn right on Lac Lavon Drive for 1.5 miles. The park is on the left. Watch for event signs!!

Parking: Limited parking near pavilion. Additional parking 1 block south.

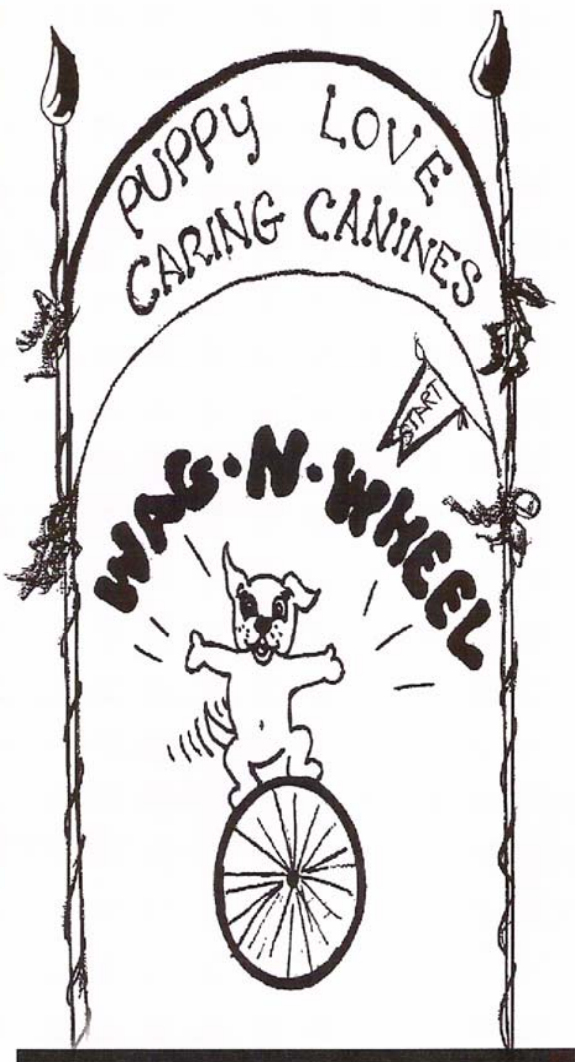
